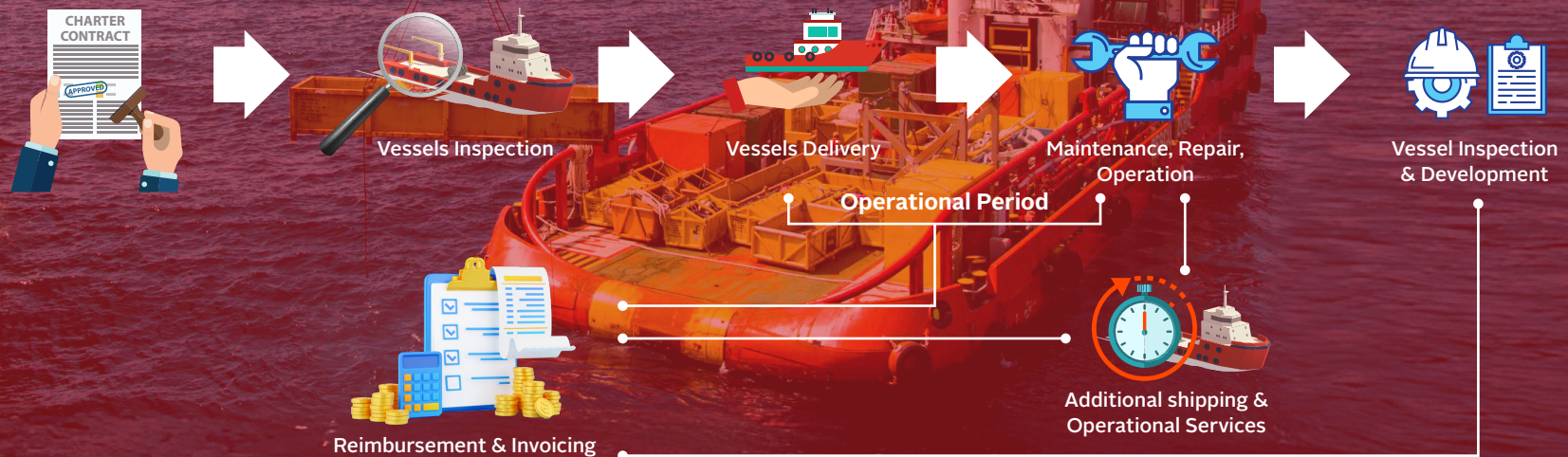

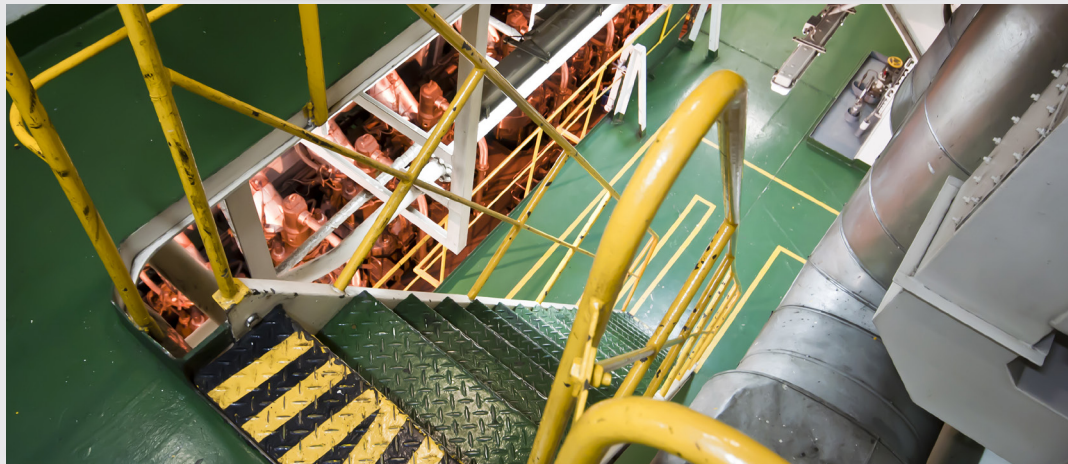

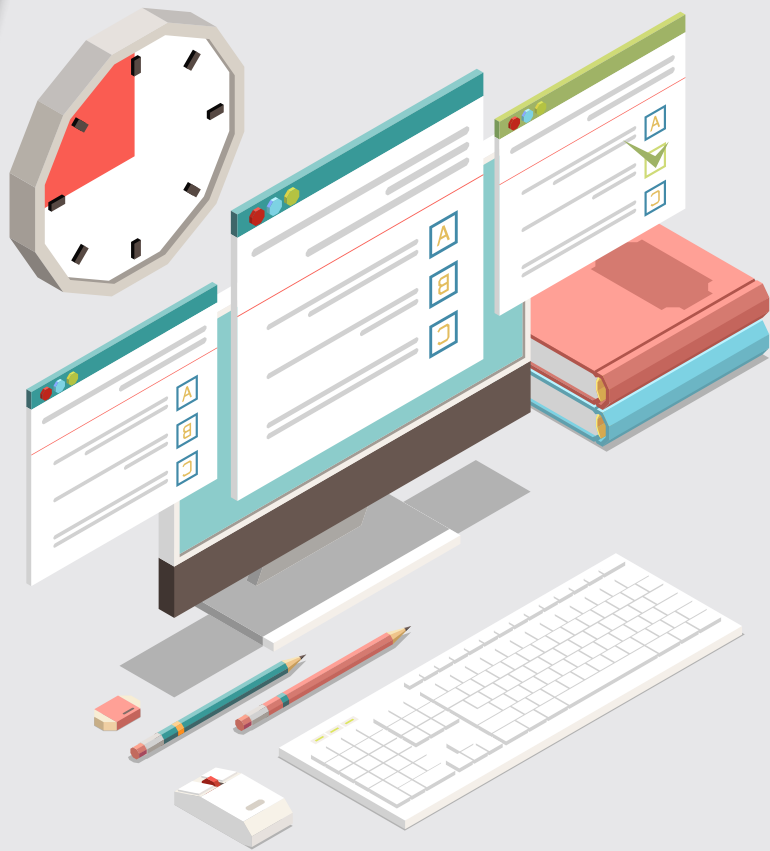
Shipping Agency

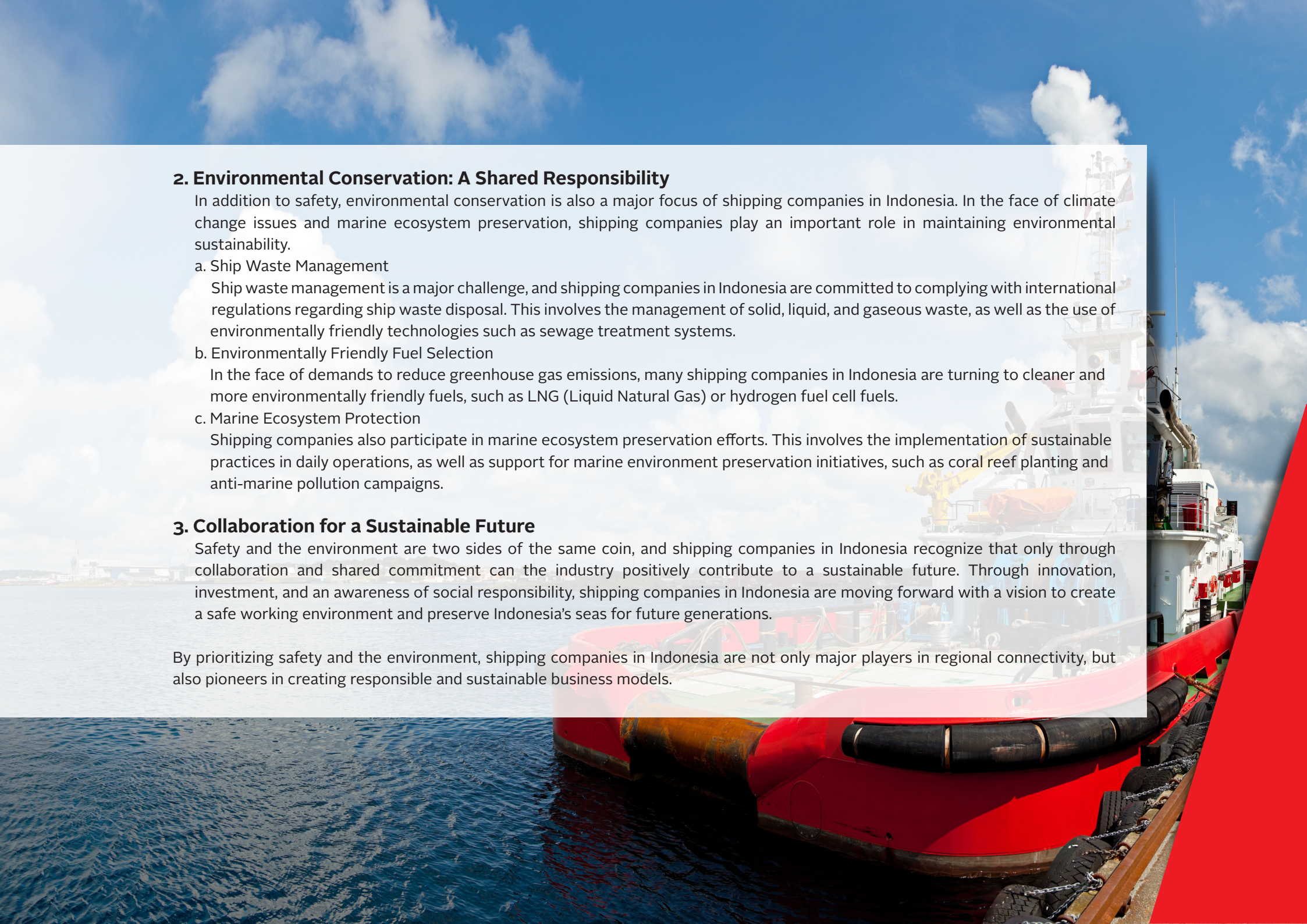
c. Marine Ecosystem Protection
